PAGEANT RULES:

- 1.) Pageant is open to all parishes; restricted to Louisiana residents only.
- 2.) All contestants must be single, never married.
- 3.) All contestants must not be nor have ever been pregnant, or have had a child.
- 4.) All contestants must be of good moral character and never convicted of a felony.
- 5.) Any contestant that marries, becomes pregnant, or is convicted of a felony will not be allowed to compete and entry fees will not be returned.
- 6.) In the event, any Queen holding title marries, becomes pregnant, or is convicted of a felony-they will lose their title, return their crown and banner in the same condition it was given in. If crown and banner are not in same condition that they were awarded in, Queen will be responsible to replace them. 1st Runner up of that category will become the new Queen. No entry fees will be returned!
- 7.) All contestants are to submit an 8x10 Black and White photography for photogenic competition with entry fee & form. No color photos! Photos can be taken professionally-HOWEVER, NO touched-up or airbrushed photos will be allowed!!! If there is ANY question, photo will be discarded!
- 8.) 9.) The "walk pattern" or "instructions" for stage presentation for Baby Miss-Junior Miss will be the standard T pattern. If you have any questions about this please contact the director.
- 10.) **ALL CONTESTANTS AND PARENTS MUST treat fellow contestants and parents with respect. If competing in the Louisiana Doll Festival Pageant-YOU ARE APPLYING FOR A JOB AS A ROLE MODEL! You will act in a respectful way at ALL TIMES!**
- 11.) **ALL CONTESTANTS and/or FAMILY/GUESTS must act in a respectful way! All decisions are final -harassment of any kind, will not be tolerated! Anyone acting inappropriately can and will be asked to leave the premises.**
- 12.) All contestants can receive their scores. They must submit a self-addressed & stamped envelope with their entry fees and forms. All others will be discarded. This must be sent back with the entry fee.
- 13.) Miss Teen La. Doll Festival & Miss La. Doll Festival understand and agree to be in the following events & parades with transportation of their choice which are deemed mandatory unless discussed otherwise with pageant director:
 - *Contraband Days-Lake Charles, Louisiana (May) 2 appearances during festival w/Crown & Banner-Mandatory Queen Only
 - *Contraband Days Parade-Lake Charles, Louisiana (May) Teen & Queen
 - *Beauregard Parish Fair-DeRidder, Louisiana (October) Tuesday night & Friday or Saturday night appearance at fair with Crown & Banner-Mandatory Queen Only
 - *Beauregard Parish Fair Parade-DeRidder, Louisiana (October) Teen & Queen
 - *Beauregard Christmas- DeRidder, Louisiana (December) Teen & Queen
 - *Main Mardi Gras Parade-Lake Charles, Louisiana (January-February) Teen & Queen
 - *2009 Louisiana Doll Festival Friday & Saturday with Crown & Banner at all times! - Teen & Queen
 - *FOR QUEEN ONLY-Throughout year, must make special appearances. Director will get with Queen's schedule to find out before setting dates. Example of appearances-Schools, Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Club Luncheon Meetings, Ads for the Newspapers, Pictures for Advertisement.
- *IF QUEEN DOES NOT FULFILL HER DUTIES THROUGHOUT HER REIGN THE PAGEANT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO PASS THE TITLE TO THE FIRST RUNNER UP. THE QUEEN WILL NO LONGER COMPETE IN LAFF QUEEN OF QUEENS PAGEANT. THE FIRST RUNNER UP WILL GO ON TO REPRESENT THE FESTIVAL AT QUEEN OF QUEENS. THIS WILL BE TAKEN VERY SERIOUSLY!!**
- *All other Queen's are encouraged and welcome to participate in as many events and parades as they would like! Teen & Miss must have permission from Director before participating in any event/pageant that requires contract.
- 14.) It is understood that The Louisiana Doll Festival Committee and Pageant Director reserve the right to use any photos for advertisement purposes.
- 15.) NO GLITZ-NO FAKE HAIR ALLOWED FOR COMPETITION PURPOSES IN THIS PAGEANT!
- 16.) MAKE-UP MUST BE AGE APPROPRIATE-REFER TO YOUR DIVISION FOR RULES.
- 17.) NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ONCE SUBMITTED!
- 18.) ANY AND ALL MONEY COLLECTED FROM THIS PAGEANT GOES TOWARD THE GROWTH OF THE LOUISIANA DOLL FESTIVAL PAGEANT. NO PERSON(S) PROFIT ANY MONEY!
- 19.) QUEEN ONLY- To compete in the Louisiana Association Fairs and Festivals Queen of Queens Competition the contestant must be 17 years of age by January 1, 2011.
